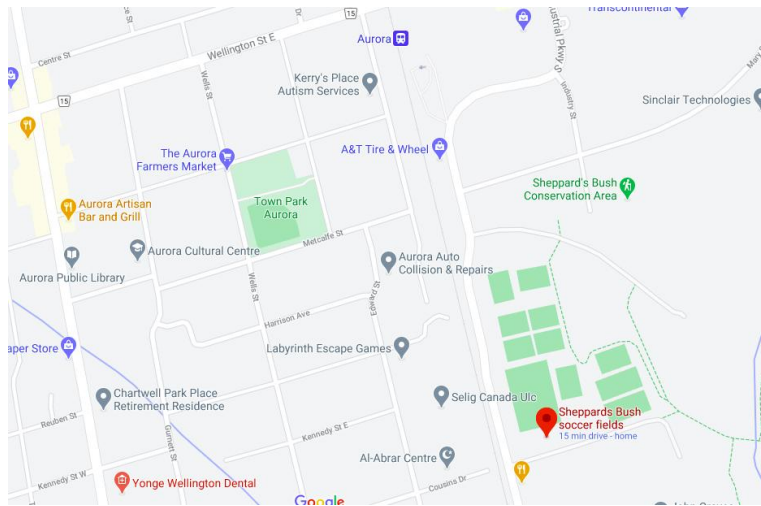




# Aurora Barbarians Emergency Action Plan

## Emergency Action Plan

1. In case of emergency (medical, fire, police) the Call person shall call 911
2. Control person will establish an isolation area around the injured player.
3. Control person shall advise medical staff of the incident so a trained Emergency Medical Responder may come down to assist
4. Control person will advise field staff that EMS has been called so they may send a staff member to the most accessible entrance (highlighted in map attached).
5. Once the emergency has been resolved, ensure all details of incident are communicated to field and team staff for reporting purposes

| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Initially takes control of situation</li> <li>Instructs player to lay still and bystanders, such as other players, not to move player</li> <li>Assess injury status of player, decide if an ambulance/medical care is required</li> <li>The most qualified person available with training in emergency control, first aid or the Rugby Canada Safety Guidelines in accordance with the Return to Play protocols</li> <li>Familiarizes themselves with the facilities emergency equipment, including hygiene and sanitation equipment</li> <li>Takes control of an emergency situation involving a transmission or outbreak until a public health authority has been notified and assumes management</li> <li>Assesses severity of suspected transmission of COVID-19, or injury situation</li> </ul> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Makes call for emergency assistance</li> <li>Knows location of emergency telephones in every facility</li> <li>Has a list of emergency telephone numbers</li> <li>Knows the best direction to the facility</li> <li>Knows the best route in and out of the facility for ambulance crew</li> <li>Communicates with the Charge Person &amp; Control Person, and informs COVID Safety Coordinator as required</li> </ul> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Establishes an isolation area around an injured player to mitigate unnecessary exposure from other participants, personnel and/or spectators</li> <li>Controls crowd and other players, coaches and volunteers and keeps them away from the Charge Person and Injured Player</li> <li>Ensures proper room to work for the Charge Person and ambulance crew</li> <li>Discusses EAP with the Facilities staff, officials and opponents</li> <li>Ensures that the route for the ambulance crew is clear and available</li> <li>Seeks highly trained medical personnel (i.e. MD, Nurse) in the facility if requested by the Charge Person</li> </ul> |
